## Queenstown Invitational Ice Figure Skating Championships 2010

**Dates:** Friday 21 – Sunday 23 May 2010

**Venue:** Queenstown Ice Arena, Park Street, Queenstown, New Zealand

This second annual event, hosted by the Queenstown Ice Skating Club, aims to be a quality event that will provide the best available practice & competition times for competitors. This competition is a chance for skaters to gain competition experience early in the season building up to their pinnacle event later in the year. This year we have the first perpetual trophy, **Loris Mills Cup for Ladies**. Loris has been involved in skating in the Queenstown Lakes District for over 40 years and is still an active competitor. Loris was awarded Life Membership to the Queenstown Ice Skating Club at our inaugural Queenstown Invitational Ice Figure Skating Championships in 2009.

**Please Note:** Skaters must be a member of a club affiliated to the NZISA or their country's governing body.

Beginner & Juvenile grades may be divided by age if required, depending on the number of entries received. If necessary, numbers may be limited due to ice time availability. The above will be at the discretion of the organisers.

**Closing Date: Thursday April 22 2010**

*(Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the competition co-ordinator, an additional fee of \$50.00 will be charged for entries accepted after the closing date).*

**Entries:** Must be submitted via the skaters Home Club Secretary or via State Associations on the applicable form. Club/State Secretary to post completed entries, club summary form and payment to:

**Withdrawals:** Refund of entries only with medical certificate.

**Trophies:** Will be awarded to the first three places in each event regardless of the club or country that they represent. The **Loris Mills Cup for Ladies** is a perpetual trophy and will be awarded to the Skater of the Championship but will stay in its home town.

**Technical Requirements & Eligibility:** All disciplines and grades as per current NZISA Rules & Regulations for 2010 (ISU Junior & Senior 2010/2011 rules will apply). These are posted on the NZISA website [www.nzisa.com](http://www.nzisa.com) Rules & Regulations, Competitions (200 sections) with the exception of the following:

**Beginner Grade:** Skaters must hold no NZISA medal tests and have not competed in this grade in the previous skating season. Skaters must also be TC registered.

- Optional jump (selected from Loop, Flip or Lutz)
- Salchow
- Toe loop
- One foot spin (min 3 revs)
- 1 Spiral on a bold curve
- Simple step sequence (one half the length of the rink)

Skaters skate one Freeskate programme up to 2 minutes 15 seconds but may be less provided that all the elements have been included. The time to be taken from the moment the competitor begins to move or skate. Any element completed after the time allowed will be considered as omitted.

**Note:** *A waltz jump is a non classified jump (less than 1 revolution) and therefore does not have a scale of value.*

**Program Content Sheets:** As per 2010 NZISA Rule 203.7

**Tests:** Tests are scheduled between 12:00 – 2:00pm on the Friday. If we receive more entries or test requests than the ice time we have allocated then we may move the test day and or time. Please advise your Club Secretary if you require a test/s at the same time you submit your competition entry.

**Accreditation:** The official accreditation desk will be located at the skate hire counter at the Queenstown Ice Arena. Team leaders please pick up your competitors program & nametags.

**Music:** Must be on CDs. All CDs **must** be clearly marked with the competitors name, club, grade, event, & length of music. The official competition CDs must be submitted at the skate hire counter at the Queenstown Ice Arena and placed in the appropriate marked box before skaters commence their official practices. Backup copies should be carried.

**Draws:** To Be Advised.

**Photography:** There is to be no flash photography as it may impact on the skater's performance.

**Video Recording:** Individuals using video cameras will be required to register at the accreditation desk on the day of the event. A video pass will be issued at no charge. Only people who have a video permit may video and only their own skater. If you wish to video other skaters then written permission must be obtained from the skater/s concerned, or in the case of minors, their parents or guardians. **Videoing can only be done in the designated area.**
